Student Financial Planning Checklist

DECEMBER

- Attend financial aid night at area high school

JANUARY

- Complete the FAFSA application online at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- Contact your State Grant Agency regarding state grant application procedures and deadlines. (the high school guidance office will have this information.)
- Within 1-6 weeks after submitting the FAFSA, you will receive a Student Aid Report. If corrections are necessary, log on to www.fafsa.ed.gov to make corrections

FEBRUARY

- Send to Norwich Student Financial Planning Office
 - All additional requested documents

***Priority deadline for financial aid is MARCH 1st.**

MARCH

Once the financial aid process is complete, student will receive:

- Financial Aid Award letter and other forms
- Student Award Acceptance Form
- Request for missing documentation
- Signed Student Award Acceptance Form

Complete online if applicable

- Federal Loan Entrance Counseling
- Master Promissory Note

**The financial aid process cannot be completed unless all paperwork is received complete and on time.

APRIL

- Review the payment plan you receive from Norwich

****Contact Student Financial Planning for assistance in selecting alternative financial options.**

MAY

- Sign up for payment plan, if applicable.
- The \$250 Tuition Deposit is due no later than May 1st to secure a space in the fall class and start the registration process.

JUNE

- Secure alternative financing, if applicable.

JULY

- The Bursar's Office makes available online the fall tuition and fees bill. Review carefully and address questions to the Bursar's Office at (802) 485-2055.

AUGUST

- All financial aid funds are applied to the student's account in accordance with state and federal regulations.
