Business	

- Rooks who intend to play varsity athletics are required to wear business attire for away competitions.
- Some professors require business attire for presentations or class trips. For class related business attire, the Rook should find out during the first week of classes whether or not this will be a requirement for class.
- Male business attire includes- business suit or sport coat with dress shirt and tie, dress pants, leather belt, dress shoes.
- Female business attire includes- business suit (pant or skirt) with hosiery and closed toe shoes with or without a heel; or tailored separates such as skirts, slacks, blouses, and sweaters, with hosiery and closed toe shoes with heel or without heel.
- □ Rooks serving in the National Guard or Reserves may bring uniforms or equipment necessary for drill weekends.

Laundry

We recommend Rooks use the linen service offered at the Cadet Uniform Store. If your Rook plans to do laundry in the barracks instead of using the linen service, then the Rook will need to bring:

Standard size pillow
2 White standard size pillowcases
4 White twin size standard flat sheets (no fitted sheets)
6 White bath size towels

The Uniform Store offers linen packets that meet the NUCC standards for purchase in advance to be picked up on arrival day.

Full Set: \$45 (4 flat sheets, 2 pillowcases, 6 towels, 1 pillow)

Half Set: \$22 (2 flat sheets, 1 pillowcase, 3 towels)

Pillow: \$7 (1 pillow)

Proof of Identification

All Rooks will receive a Norwich student photo ID during Rook Arrival Day in processing. A second form of photo ID is recommended.

ROTC branches require an original or certified certificate of birth and original social security card (or proof of citizenship as applicable) so they can make a copy of the documents. ROTC branches will contact Rooks prior to arrival if more information is needed.
